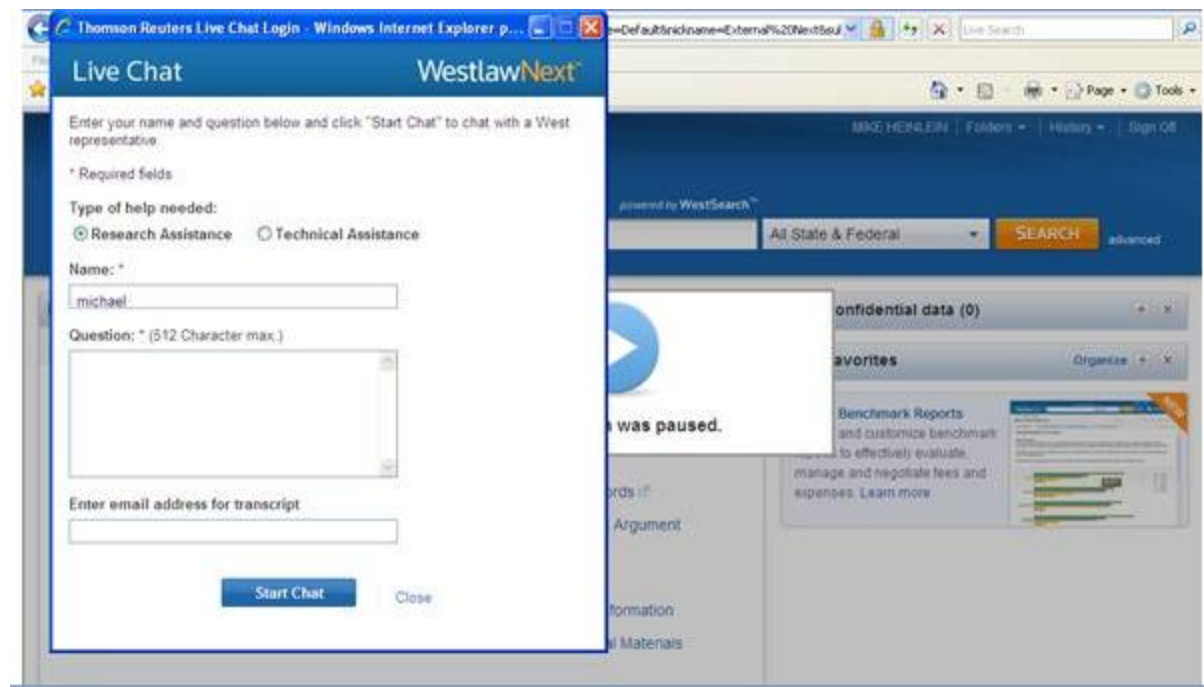

Now you can use online chat functionality to send your research questions to the industry's premier team of legal research assistance professionals. Users simply click on "Live Help" on WestlawNext to open a new chat window. Get assistance doing a research task, for quick answers or for general WestlawNext questions. If a user provides an email address, a transcript will be sent.

Live Help is available Monday – Friday from 7:00 a.m. to midnight (excluding the holidays). The WestlawNext session IS paused during the chat. As always, you can also contact a Reference Attorney at any time, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, 365 days a year at 1-800-REF-ATTY (1-800-733-2889).
