Thomson Reuters ProView is a professional grade platform that allows you to interact with your eBooks in entirely new ways. That's because ProView was specifically designed with our customers in mind.

Some of the product's unique features include:

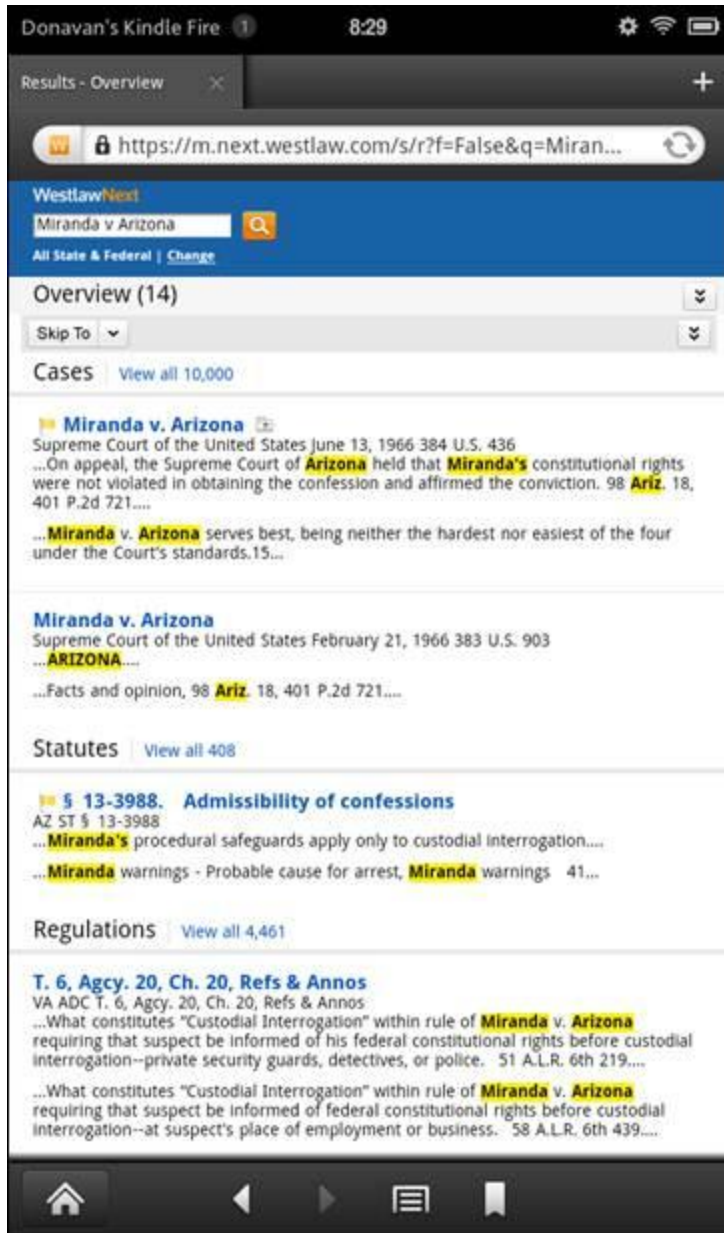
- Full-text search capabilities, including the ability to highlight information. The professional-grade search is based on similar Boolean search technology that powers Westlaw & WestlawNext. There are some exceptions – please ask your me for more details.
- Users have the ability to make notes and annotations within the material. They are stored securely online and can be recovered easily if the iPad is lost or stolen.
- Titles purchased on subscription can quickly and easily be updated as new editions and updates become available. Additionally, users' notes and annotations can be transferred to the updated versions.
- Documents can be viewed in both an eReader format and a page-view format, which is beneficial for law students and other professionals who need to know on what printed page something appears.

Westlaw Doc & Form Builder: Two New Options!

Westlaw Doc & Form Builder offers a convenient, easy-to-use tool to help legal departments complete documents and forms faster. Doc & Form Builder saves customer-entered data to reuse for additional forms, with secure storage, convenient foldering, and Favorites to manage documents.

Doc & Form Builder uses documents from familiar, trusted sources, with links to statutory and analytical content on Westlaw.com and WestlawNext™. Documents are updated automatically, so you always have the most current version, with no software downloads to worry about.

Westlaw Doc & Form Builder can shorten greatly the time it takes to complete forms. A couple of recent enhancements can shorten the process further in key situations:

- **Download Blank Form:** If you decide you want a particular blank form in your Westlaw Doc & Form Builder subscription without going through the assembly process, you can simply click the new **Download Blank Form** icon where it appears in a result list, the form preview, a form set, or the Client/Case Manager. The blank form can then be opened or saved in Word or PDF, whichever format is available.
- **Default Answers:** If most of the legal forms you complete involve the same county, party, party type, or other detail, you can click **Default Answers** during the assembly process and specify a detail to be entered automatically each time a specific question arises. (You can choose to overwrite a Default Answer at any time.)

PLI Practice Guides: 5 new Guides that provide No-Nonsense answers for busy practitioners

As its name suggests, Practising Law Institute (PLI) focuses on the needs of the busy practitioner, not the legal scholar. If your organization practices in the areas of antitrust, securities, intellectual property, labor management, or medical devices litigation or regulation, they will want to know about five PLI practice guides recently released on WestlawNext and in the following databases on Westlaw:

- Antitrust Law Answer Book (PLIREF-ALAB)
- Conducting Due Diligence in a Securities Offering (PLIREF-CDDSO)
- Intellectual Property Law Answer Book (PLIREF-IPLAB)
- Labor Management Answer Book (PLIREF-LMLAB)
- Medical Devices Law and Regulation Answer Book (PLIREF-MDLRAB)

PLIREF-CDDSO contains the full-text of Valerie Ford Jacob and Stephanie J. Goldstein's guide to the mechanics of several types of due diligence needed for securities offerings, including legal, business, financial and accounting, employee benefits, corporate governance under Sarbanes-Oxley, intellectual property, and environmental. Coverage is current.

The remaining four publications are guides to specific practice areas, intuitively organized in question-and-answer format. (Typical section name: *When Can a Patent Owner Recover Attorney Fees?*) Answers are succinct and easy-to-read, with links to cited authorities.

For ease of use, the Table of Contents service is available for each of these publications. Coverage is current for each.
