

Hoover's Company Profiles and Company Records–Basic: Check out the new look and feel!

If you ever use Westlaw to retrieve background, corporate structure, and financial information on a company, you're probably familiar with Hoover's Company Profiles (HOOVCP) and Hoover's Company Capsules (HOOVCC) databases, two reliable sources of business information on more than 44,000 public and private companies.

Rest assured, these resources are still on Westlaw, and the following changes have taken effect:

- **New databases:** HOOVCP and HOOVCC will be replaced with the new Hoover's Company Profiles (HOOVCP-PROF) and Hoover's Company Records–Basic (HOOVCC-BASIC) databases. Coverage remains the same.
- **New content center:** These databases are now provided by Risk & Fraud (Public Records), rather than NewsRoom.
- **New features:** The new databases have better search functionality, and their reports enjoy a more readable format. In addition, only the current version of a report is retrieved for a particular company.
- **Consistency with Westlaw Public Records:** As in other Westlaw Public Records databases, Find and alert services are not available in HOOVCP-PROF and HOOVCC-BASIC.

If you currently have access to Hoover's news content, you will have access to Hoover's Risk & Fraud (Public Records) content. (If you try to access HOOVCP or HOOVCC, you will be automatically redirected to the new databases.)

WestlawNext iPad App 2.3.0—ready for download!

WestlawNext iPad App 2.3.0 is available for downloading from the [Apple iTunes app store](#). Among the highlights of the latest version:

- **Search text within document:** You can now use Boolean terms and connectors to search within a document for specific terms, just as you can from WestlawNext on your desktop.
- **Folders "Shared With Me":** You can use your iPad to view folders (and contents) that other WestlawNext users have shared with you. Full folder sharing initiated from the WestlawNext iPad App will be a feature in a future version.
- **KeyCite flag synchronization:** The KeyCite status flags on documents saved while offline are updated when you return to those documents online. As a result, documents have consistent KeyCite status, no matter how you view them.
- **All delivery preferences recognized:** Delivery preferences set from the desktop are recognized on the iPad, too.

Advanced command: Everything you need to know

Suppose you want to search for an exact phrase or for specific terms connected by an AND or OR operator. As you probably know, you can do this by clicking **advanced** on the appropriate page to navigate to an Advanced Search template. What you might not know is that WestlawNext will also run your Boolean terms and connectors query exactly as written if you type *adv:* or *advanced:* immediately preceding your query terms (e.g., **adv: tax or taxpayer**).

Reuters Blogs: Search them on Westlaw

Q: Last week, I wanted to read financial blogger Felix Salmon's oft-cited post about the valuation of Groupon. I was able to retrieve many of his posts from the All News Plus Wires (ALLNEWSPLUS) and Blogs on Demand (BLOGOD) databases on Westlaw—but not his post about Groupon. Can I assume it's not on Westlaw?

A: Try again this week. Salmon's post on Groupon is from his highly regarded Reuters blog (named by *Time* as one of the finest 25 financial blogs). Previously available only at blogs.reuters.com, Reuters blogs are now available on WestlawNext and in the Reuters Blogs database (REUTERSBLOGS) on Westlaw. They include the following:

Great for WestClip alerts! You can use WestClip to automatically monitor REUTERSBLOGS for posts from a specific blog or on a specific topic. For example, you can create a WestClip entry for the Felix Salmon blog by adding a prelim field (pr) restriction to your query, e.g., **pr(felix /3 salmon)**.

My Content: It's easy to keep track of the content in your WestlawNext plan

If you want to run a search on WestlawNext but want to know whether particular content is included in your WestlawNext subscription, My Content will quickly set you straight.

Just click **My Content** on the Tools tab. My Content displays a page labeled *[name of your organization] Content*, which contains a complete list of content included in your subscription. Many items on the list are linked to content pages from which you can run searches. The My Content page also contains tools to navigate the list alphabetically or by content type, depending on the sorting method selected. You can use the text box at the top of the page to search the list for terms.

In addition, you can download the list in PDF at no charge.

World Intellectual Property Rights and Remedies: A bird's eye view of international IP

If your business client comes to you with a specific issue in one area of intellectual property, you can often reach for a single publication devoted to that subject. But what if your client plans to release a product in another country and needs to know how that product would be governed by multiple areas of IP (including copyright, trademark, patent, and licensing) under that country's laws and under any of several international agreements?

You can still reach for a single publication: *World Intellectual Property Rights and Remedies*. You can consult this publication using the World Intellectual Property Rights and Remedies database (WIPRR) on Westlaw.

WIPRR contains the full text of this comprehensive loose-leaf resource, edited by Dennis Campbell of the Centre for International Legal Studies. This resource is valuable as a "how to" guide for a specific country, as a source of primary law and analysis, and as a "big picture" of the interconnected national and international IP laws. Features include the following:

- **Intuitive organization:** Access WIPRR and click **Table of Contents**. You'll see that this publication is divided into two parts: Commentary (organized by country or international agreement) and Primary Law and Commentary (organized by country). Therefore, all material affecting IP in a specific country is gathered within a few convenient places of a single publication.
- **Local experts:** The authors of the country-specific chapters are IP experts from the country at issue.
- **Worldwide coverage:** The Commentary part discusses the law of 50 countries, the European Union, and the major international IP agreements (e.g., the Revised Berne Convention). The Primary Law and Commentary part provides English translations and analysis of the IP law of 30 major countries.
- **Integrated commentary:** Practice guidance and comments are interspersed in the statutory text.
- **Table of Contents service:** The Table of Contents service provides an easy, fast way to browse the contents of a relevant chapter and retrieve sections by clicking section names.
