1. License.

a. Grant. West hereby grants Subscriber a worldwide non-exclusive, non-transferable, revocable, limited license to download to your mobile device and/or access online the eBook(s) via ProView . Browser-based online access for eBooks that are not updated or for which Subscriber did purchase a license for updates, may be available for a limited period of time. The eBook(s) consist(s) of West-owned and/or licensed content on select topics. Subscriber is licensed to use content made available to Subscriber in the eBook(s) ("Content") solely in the regular course of legal and other research and related work. If West loses the right to offer any Content or West is otherwise unable to offer Content through ProView, West may terminate Subscriber's access to that Content, including any associated notes and annotations. West may modify ProView at any time without notice to Subscriber. At West's sole discretion and using commercially reasonable practices, West may provide the Content in another media format. West, at its sole discretion may update Subscriber to a more recent version of the eBook(s) if necessary to maintain access to the Content.

b. Updates. License for eBooks that are updated includes updates to the most current version of each edition of the eBook(s) ordered herein which are available during Subscriber's subscription term. During the term of Subscriber's subscription, Subscriber will have browser-based online access to the most current version of the eBook(s).

c. Permitted Use. Subscriber may: (i) use, browse, and search the Content; (ii) quote and excerpt from the Content by electronic cutting and pasting or other means into Subscriber's work product created in the regular course of its research and related work ("Work Product"); and (iii) print and make copies of insubstantial portions of the Content for distribution to third parties.

d. Limitations. 3. Notes and Annotations. Subscriber may create notes and annotations throughout the eBook which will be web hosted by West and will be accessible by Subscriber as set forth herein.
