

CALIFORNIA JURY INSTRUCTION SELECTOR 5.3 INSTALLATION GUIDE

SYSTEM REQUIREMENTS

Operating System	For LOCAL and WORKSTATION installations, one of the following is required: Microsoft Windows® 7 (32- or 64-bit), Vista (SP 2) (32- or 64-bit), or XP (SP 3). For NETWORK installations, a Microsoft Windows®-based server environment (Windows® Server 2003 or later) is recommended.
Processor	Pentium III 500 Mhz
Memory	128 MB of available RAM (256 MB recommended)
Disk space	250 MB of available hard-disk space
Monitor	800 x 600 resolution or higher
Printer	Laser printer with Printer Control Language (PCL) 4 or 5 support

Westlaw access	To use Westlaw links, Microsoft Internet Explorer 6.0, Firefox 2.0 or Safari 2.0 or later is required, with JavaScript and cookies enabled, frames fully supported and pop-ups allowed.

Alternate Operating Environments: California Jury Instruction Selector is designed to be compatible with the operating systems listed in the system requirements and to function correctly under the installation configurations outlined in the installation guide. Customer Technical Support is available to all users working under those conditions. West does not claim compatibility with any other operating systems, multi-user environments, or installation configurations such as Mac OS, Linux, Novell, Citrix, Terminal Services, etc. We are unable to provide support for California Jury Instruction Selector in any operating environment or installation configuration not specifically included in the installation guide.

Network Distribution: Workstation installations must be run on all computers using the network configuration (see below, "NETWORK & WORKSTATION INSTALLATIONS"). For your convenience, workstation installs can be run directly from the MSI (CA Jury Instruction Selector.msi), bypassing setup.exe. To do so, the following must be installed first: (1) .NET Framework version 3.5 SP1; and (2) MDAC drivers version 2.8. Both are available from Microsoft's Web site.

Because of the number of different network distribution applications available, West cannot support or offer advice on how to distribute our software using third-party network distribution software such as ZENWorks or Microsoft's SMS software.

HOW TO INSTALL JURY INSTRUCTION SELECTOR

To begin, insert the CD into your computer, and open **setup.exe**. Follow the on-screen prompts until you reach the "Setup Type" screen.

FOR ONE COMPUTER

If you intend to use the program on only one computer, choose "Local" on the "Setup Type" screen. Then follow the on-screen prompts to finish the installation.

FOR SEVERAL COMPUTERS

If you have purchased a network license, you can share the jury instruction database and your case files among several networked computers, or "workstations." This set-up is a two-step process:

Step 1. Place the *shared material* on your **server**
On the "Setup Type" screen, choose "Network." When prompted, choose the directory where you would like to place the material.

Step 2. Place the *program* on each of your **workstations**
On the "Setup Type" screen, choose "Workstation." When prompted, browse to the server directory where you installed the shared material and click on `jis.jid`. Repeat for each workstation.

KEY CODES

If you are installing the program for the first time or activating a new module, you will be asked to enter a key code during installation. On the "Rights Management" screen, next to the name of each module, you will see either the Jury Instruction Selector logo (already licensed) or a padlock icon (unlicensed). If necessary, enter your key code, and click the "Unlock" button. Repeat if you have a second key code.

INTERIM UPDATES

Between CDs, downloadable updates are posted periodically at west.thomson.com:

- "Web Updates" offer newly-published jury instructions
- "Service Packs" provide critical software updates

Downloading and installing Web Updates is straightforward and fast, and network users only need to install them on the server. Service Packs are also simple to install. However, network users may need to install them on more than one machine.
